Meta Peace Team has been invited to provide a peaceful presence at the U.S./Mexico border, especially in Tijuana, where families fleeing violence in their home countries are experiencing an acute politically-created humanitarian crisis. People are struggling to survive in crowded encampments where food, water, access to sanitation, and security are in short supply.

While other groups are offering much-needed direct aid, MPT is being asked to contribute by focusing on our areas of expertise - violence reduction work.

We are currently seeking applicants for our next Team to the US/Mexico border. An exact date for the Fall Team will be determined soon.

- Applicants should be prepared to spend approximately 10 days at the border.
- You will need to have a valid passport or an “enhanced driver’s license”
- Some level of Spanish or French proficiency is **highly** recommended (while the majority of those seeking asylum speak Spanish, there are over 70 different countries that are represented at this border. French is the next most common language spoken)
- Anticipated cost – per person - is \$815 plus airfare to San Diego, CA. We will help you coordinate fundraising.
